

PARKING INFORMATION FOR 2019 JANUARY INTENSIVE

When Do I Have to Pay For Parking?

Parking permits and meter regulations are in effect every week throughout the year regardless of breaks in instruction, including during the January Intensive. The days and hours of these regulations are:

- Monday – Thursday: 7:00 AM - 10:00 PM
- Friday: 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM
- After 5:00 PM on Friday through 7:00 AM on Monday, parking is FREE at any meter or in any lot

Where Can I Park/How Can I Pay For My Parking?

- **Daily Parking Permits:** you can purchase a one-time daily use parking permit for \$3.50 from any of the parking lot kiosks on campus, or from the Parking Services office in the G11 parking lot off of Rossow Street. Permits are valid in any General Lot (not Staff lots) from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM. *See attached map for specific lot locations (circled in red). Please note: Permit kiosks only accept credit/debit cards or coins. No cash or checks! Permits are also not valid at parking meters or in Staff Parking lots before 5:00 PM.*
- **Parking Meters:** parking meters are available throughout campus and its surrounding areas. They cost 75 cents/hour and have a 10 hour limit (at one time). Some common parking meter locations are: along B Street, 17th Street, Union Street, and 14th Street. *See attached map for meter locations.*
- **Free 4 Hour Parking Zones:** There are free 4 hour parking zones on most of the streets surrounding campus. Just make sure to move your car in the allotted time or you may find yourself with a parking ticket from the City of Arcata. Should you receive a parking ticket while in one of these zones, you should contact the Arcata Police Department at 736 F Street. Some common 4 hour zones are: South Union Street, West 14th Street, Sunset Avenue, and G Street. *See attached map for 4 hour parking zone locations.*
